***Until When*, by Dahna Abourahme (2004)**

An intimate portrait of a Palestinian family's life in Dheisheh Refugee Camp, Bethlehem, during the second intifada.

***Little Town of Bethlehem*, by Jim Hanon (2010)**

Three faiths, three men, and their ongoing struggle to sustain non-violent alternatives despite the sustained violence that has dehumanized all sides.

***Peace, Propaganda, and the Promised Land*, by Jhally & Ratzkoff (2003)**

A striking comparison of media coverage of the crisis in the Middle East, zeroing in on how distortions in U.S. coverage reinforce false perceptions of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.
